This game is very simple. Name 2 objects and ask your child if they go together. For example, you might say “apple and orange...do they go together? “Your child should say “yes.”

Tips

- Make sure to think of pairs that do not go together such as “piano and hamburger.” Your child should say “no.”
- To make this game educational and to introduce categorization, talk about why things do or don't go together. For example, you can say “apple and orange go together because they are fruit.” “Piano and hamburger don't go together because a piano is a musical instrument and a hamburger is a food.”
