## How To Play

While playing with your child, ask about where you would find certain toys.

## Ideas To Try

- Cars: Outside, On a road
- Play Food: Kitchen, Restaurant
- Tea Set: Kitchen
- Blocks: Playroom
- Animals: Farm, Zoo, Home
- Trains: Train tracks, Outside
- Planes: Airport, Sky
- Bus: Street, School

Try to make your questions as natural as possible and try to avoid playtime turning into a quiz. To accomplish this, ask questions while you play such as:
