# Car Game

## Needed Materials

Play cars

## How To Play

Get out some play cars and a ramp. If you don't have a car ramp, you can make one out of pillows or by turning a hardcover book upside down. Have the cars go up and down the ramp.

To initially teach this concept, take a car and say "up, up, up, up..." slowly as the car goes up. This builds excitement and captures your child's attention. Then, once the car reaches the top, say "down" and let the car fall down fast. Children usually find this funny and remain interested for a few minutes!

Of course, you can play this game any which way. When playing, remember to talk about up and down and the rest of the concepts listed below.
