# Where Questions Reading

## Needed Materials

A book your child knows well

## How To Play

Sit down and read with your child. It is important to pick a story that your child already knows. This way he/she doesn't have to learn new vocabulary and learn how to answer "where" questions at the same time.

When a character enters a new a location, ask your child "where is \_\_\_\_ (name of character) now?" Wait for a response. If your child says the correct answer, praise him/her and keep reading.

If your child doesn't know how to answer the question or says the wrong answer, point to the picture and repeat the question. If he/she still doesn't know how to answer it, say the answer and ask him/her to repeat it.

## Tip

Don't ask too many questions while reading. Just a few each night.
