Where Questions Where Should We Go?

How To Play

When driving, biking or out for a walk, ask your child a question..."where are we going?"

It is very simple!

There are more creative ways to play this game; however, they may be suitable for older children.

Variations

While out, point to another person in a car and ask:

- "Where do you think he is going?"
- or... find an animal and ask "where is _____ (name of animal) going?"
- or...talk about your favorite places and ask "where do you really want to go?"

Ask a question and wait for a response. If your child makes a mistake, point out the correct answer and explain why.
